A week ago, we learned that Hecate Energy's initial proposal for the Shepherd's Run solar project is no longer feasible due to the loss of 59.77 acres. It would be counterproductive to proceed with the scheduled public statement hearings as the current proposal is now moot. Instead, Hecate has an important opportunity to introduce a revised plan, choosing a safer and more suitable location for Shepherd's Run. At which point, I believe ORES should schedule new hearings to gather community input. For these reasons, I believe the public commenting periods scheduled from January 9th through the 11th should be postponed and rescheduled if and when a new plan comes forward.
